

Fall Graduation Ceremony of Nagoya University was held on Sep 27, 2021. Twenty-four students including 21 international students received diplomas from the School of Agricultural Sciences or the Graduate School of Bioagricultural Sciences.

Nagoya University adopts an academic year system of fall admissions for certain students, a majority of whom are students of international programs.
